City of South Perth 2011 Emerging Artist Award Prize Pool

\$4,000 City of South Perth Emerging Artist Award (Acquisitive)

All works entered into the City of South Perth Emerging Artist Award are eligible to receive this Award. The work receiving this Award, including works identified 'not for sale', will become the property of the City of South Perth and the prize money will be accepted in lieu of the sale price.

\$500 IGA Como Best Work on a Local Theme Award

At the discretion of the judges, any work depicting, in title or content, the City of South Perth's natural or built environment, lifestyle or landmarks, will automatically be eligible to receive this Award.

\$500 City of South Perth and MillPoint Caffe Bookshop Young Artist Award

Works entered by participants aged 25 years or under at date of entry will be automatically eligible to receive this Award.

\$500 John McGrath MLA Best Local Artist Award

Works entered by artists living in the City of South Perth (suburbs of South Perth, Kensington, Como, Manning, Salter Point, Karawara and Waterford) will be automatically eligible to receive this Award.

\$500 Karalee Tavern People's Choice Award

This Award will be presented to the work that receives the greatest number of votes from exhibition visitors by the close of the exhibition period.

Conditions of Entry

1. All entrants must be emerging artists, which for the purpose of this competition shall mean that:
 - You are yet to receive national recognition on a commercial scale for your art;
 - You sell your works for less than \$5,000;
 - Your sole income is not a product of the art work;
 - You have not been part of a major exhibition in a commercial or public gallery.
2. Entries are limited to one (1) work per artist.
3. Entries must be submitted on a CD (in jpg format).
4. Works are hung at the discretion of the City of South Perth. The City of South Perth does not accept responsibility for the visual interpretation of any works.
5. It is the artist's responsibility to ensure that their work is not subject to defamation or in violation of copyright laws.
6. The City of South Perth will exercise reasonable care but will not accept responsibility for loss or damage while works are in its keeping.
7. Works selected for exhibition will be fully insured for the duration of the exhibition.
8. The Awards (with the exception of the People's Choice) will be announced at an invitation-only Awards ceremony on Thursday 27 October 2011 and will be published in the *Southern Gazette*.
9. Entrants agree to allow the City of South Perth to reproduce entries in print, film or digital format for promotion, education or documentation purposes.
10. The City of South Perth 2011 Emerging Artist Award exhibition is a selected works exhibition.
11. 2D works submitted must:
 - a) Be original and completed after 1 July 2010
 - b) Not exceed a maximum size of 1.2m x 1.2m
 - c) Not exceed 15kg in weight
 - d) Be suitably presented for exhibition (i.e. dry, properly affixed wire/cord for hanging work)
 - e) Be for sale (excluding work in the Young Artists category)3D works submitted must:
 - a) Be original and completed after 1 July 2010
 - b) Not exceed a maximum size of 95cm wide x 95cm length x 45cm in height
 - c) Not exceed 10kg in weight
 - d) Be suitably presented for exhibition
 - e) Be for sale (excluding work in the Young Artists category)

How to Enter

The City of South Perth 2011 Emerging Artist Award is open to all emerging artists within Western Australia.

To see if you are eligible, please read the Conditions of Entry.

Complete the Entry Form and submit, along with a CD comprising of a digital image (jpg) of your work.

A non-refundable registration fee of \$20 General Admission or \$15 for Young Artists (GST inc) must accompany all registrations.

Cheques and money orders should be made payable to the City of South Perth.

Registration forms must be received by or post marked no later than 5pm Friday 30 September 2011, with relevant fees paid or enclosed (cheque/money order only if mailed). Registration forms received after that date will not be accepted. Incorrect or incomplete registration forms or failure to comply with Conditions of Entry will result in disqualification.

Entry details cannot be changed after entries are submitted.

All entry fees are non-refundable.

Selection of Work

The City of South Perth 2011 Emerging Artist Award is a selected work exhibition.

Friday 30 September 2011 – entries close.

Tuesday 4 October 2011 – panel of three will view all entries and select the works to be exhibited.

Friday 7 October – Tuesday 11 October – selected entrants will be contacted and advised about delivery of works to the exhibition space.

Unsuccessful entrants will be notified via mail the following week.

Tuesday 25 October – judging of selected artworks at the Community Hall, South Perth Community Centre.

Please Note:

Works may be rejected due to poor presentation (See Conditions of Entry) If, in the panel's opinion, there is no entry of an adequate standard in a category, the panel may refrain from making an award. The panel's decisions will be final and no communication will be entered into.

Sale of Work

All exhibited work must be 'for sale', except work in the Young Artists category where sale is optional.

Sale price must include a 20% commission plus GST.

Sales price = (artists' price + 20% commission) + 10% GST.

Artists must provide their ABN number on their registration form.

Artists who do not have an ABN must provide a completed Australian Taxation Office 'Statement by a Supplier' form (www.ato.gov.au/content/downloads/nat3346.pdf).

Delivery/Collection of Work

Selected entries will be received at the City of South Perth Reception Room, Cnr Sandgate St and South Tce, South Perth on Friday 21 October from 8am – 6pm.

Work will NOT be accepted at any other location or at any other time.

Any unsold works will be available for collection on Monday 14 November from the Community Hall, South Perth Community Centre, Cnr Sandgate St and South Tce, South Perth between 9am and 6pm. Artists will be required to bring personal identification for pick up of works. Those unable to attend themselves must notify the City of the person collecting the work in their place.

Work not collected within one week of the collection date may be disposed of at the discretion of the City of South Perth.

Delivery and collection of artworks is the responsibility of the artist.

No payment will be made by the City of South Perth for charges incurred in the delivery or return of exhibits.
